Programs and Rentals

EcoTEAM

Our EcoTEAM program engages groups in environmental restoration. You will be brought to one of our many restoration sites in Pacific Spirit Regional Park where your group will remove invasive species, such as ivy and holly; or, plant native species to promote healthy ecological succession. Attendees will learn the value of team work, about the difference between native and invasive species, and gain valuable stewardship experience.

EcoWATCH

EcoWATCH is our citizen science and data collection team! Attendees will learn how to conduct water quality testing for pH, nutrient load, and more while learning about the importance of streams, wetlands, and bogs to the overall health of Pacific Spirit Park. As well, groups will also be brought on a guided nature walk to learn GPS mapping techniques and plant identification while they learn to locate and record invasive plant species. Those who join us will gain valuable work skills training, and stewardship experience.

EcoKITS

EcoKITS are self-contained educational kits that focus on four primary areas: forests, streams, ponds, and bogs! The kits are appropriate for children and youth of all ages, and are linked to curriculum foci to promote environmental education in the classroom. Leaders will be provided with all of the necessary equipment and activities to lead an interactive nature walk for their group in Pacific Spirit Regional Park!

EcoWALK

Join one of our dedicated volunteers for a guided tour of a section of Pacific Spirit Regional Park. Attendees will learn about the rich history of this park, its formation, struggles, and community. As well, learn plant identification, and about the many animals that call the park home. Who knows what we might find?!

Expectations

During the provision of programming, Pacific Spirit Park Society will provide the following:

- 1 Volunteer per 30 individuals to lead the program.
- Light refreshments and snacks may be provided.
- All equipment required to conduct the ecorestoration or citizen science initiative.

During the provision of programming, the attending organization will:

- Ensure at least 1 adult supervisor is present for every 15 minors.
- Respect the rules and bylaws of the park, and act with respect for other park users.
- Ensure attendees are dressed appropriately for the weather.
- Ensure meals for attendees: eco restoration is tough work, come prepared with your lunch.
- Ensure that at least 10 attendees are present.
- Donations are **not** required, but appreciated.
